Marcus' Note

Are Genetically Modified Organisms really safe? What about Terminator Seeds?

Imagine those living in the 1700s when Benjamin Franklin was just beginning to discover electricity. If public opinion had listened to those claiming it was the work of the devil and should be forbidden, then none of us would be living in the comfort we are used to today. And yet electricity can be used both for man and against him. Just because a few use it to torture, it doesn't mean that electricity itself is intrinsically bad and should be banned.

Here's another dilemma: should we ban aspirin and chemotherapy? Everyone knows that it can damage our bodies and of course it represents a huge source of revenue for the pharmaceutical industries whose only preoccupation is the profit they can make. And yet, it can improve the lives of millions of people, and even save them. If we were to ban them, we would never progress onto the next stage and learn how to prevent these illnesses or develop non-destructive therapies.

The same applies to GMO technology: it is a new nascent technology and like electricity, can be used for bad as well as good. The basic principle is simple, take one part of an organism and insert it into another. Nothing is created, just different combinations. Maize, for example requires a certain level of damp to grow, but in order to allow it to live in arid conditions, we can take a few genes from another plant which produces an extra-efficient rooting system and insert them into the maize plant, and thus save the lives of thousands of starving Ethiopians by allowing them to grow maize during drought.

Or one can take a natural antifungal gene (harmless to man) from a wild potato from Peru and insert it into the normal commercial potato so that it becomes naturally resistant to potato blight. No need to add artificial pesticides. It can then be grown organically, pollute less, produce more crops and save money, providing cheap healthy food for the poor.

Another benefit would be to cure Rickets among Vitamin D deficient children in India, just insert the Vitamin D genes from a fish into rice and let them grow it. Or cure children from blindness by inserting the ProVitaminA gene from the sweet potato into rice to make the more nutritious Golden Rice.

Alternatively one could insert human insulin genes into a goat so that it produces cheap and plentiful Insulin to help those with diabetes survive.

Those are all the good uses.

But of course, there are plenty of poisons which exist in nature, such as atropine in Belladonna showing that it is not because it is "natural" that it is safe, and it would be equally possible to insert the atropine gene into any vegetable and poison people. That would be a bad use!

In any case, it was not GMO technology that created the poison genes or proteins, they already existed in nature and were simply transferred from one organism into another, like changing the combination of fruit you put in a fruit salad. Adding grapes to an apple and pear desert is not going to harm anyone, humans have been eating these fruit for thousands of years. If vitamin D is good in salmon, then it is good in rice.

Or you could change the proportion of a gene which already existed in that organism anyway, like increasing the proportion of apples to pears, or even removing the pears completely. However this is no different to what happens in nature anyway with natural selection or what humans have been doing for centuries with selective breeding to make the domestic dog. And don't get on your high horse about "Terminator seeds" (where they only last one generation). It is not a dastardly plot to bankrupt the poor third-world farmer. They are not exclusive to OGM technology. They existed long before, using old fashioned selective breeding methods such as with non-fruit producing, cherry blossom trees, or the seedless grape: try planting it and it won't grow because there is no seed!

No, the problem arises when the gene from a poison is deliberately inserted into a safe organism such as with the above mentioned atropine, but this has nothing to do with GM technology, it is only the military who would attempt such a crime, it is they who invented the concept of the Trojan Horse!

And observing alterations in mice pancreatic cells following massive doses of GMO is no valid argument to abandon everything. The same thing would occur if you gave the mice exaggerated doses of natural carrots, since too much carotene can be toxic too. Everything is toxic at the wrong dose.

And don't believe those who claim the DNA itself can be harmful. It is digested like any other sugar and protein. You can write whatever poems you wish on a wedding-cake, that will never make it poisonous. And those who think that a harmless insulin protein inside a milk-producing cell will sabotage the cell's functioning (using the true meaning of

throwing "sabots" (clogs) into the factory machinery) and produce poisons, then no problem, if it really does, the cell itself will die and the organism will not develop and be cultivated. And if it turns out that there are non-propitious combinations within the cell itself, then all the more reason to continue such research to find out more to provide maximal benefit to mankind.

From December 10th to January 25th, Bishop Guide Hortense Dodo, Professor and researcher at the University of Alabama A&M in the USA, started a big campaign pro-GMO in four countries of Western Kama (Africa), namely in Ivory Coast, Burkina Faso, Benin and Togo.

She achieved amazing results :

- 7 conferences (5 in Ivory Coast, 1 in Burkina, 1 in Benin) that touched more than 1000 participants. The conference in Benin, was the most prestigious one, attended by the Minister of agriculture, 26 media representatives and more than 200 participants.
- She was on television 8 times - 5 times in Ivory Coast and 3 times in Benin during the evening news.
- 15 radio shows - 7 in Ivory Coast, 5 in Benin and 3 in Togo)
- 11 press articles (7 in Ivory Coast and 4 in Benin)

During her tour, Hortense was so brilliant in her media shows and her conferences that she has been invited to meet a few VIP including the President of Ivory Coast himself who was impressed by what she said during a radio show that he was listening in his car.

Thank you Hortense for being so available and for your exemplary punch to put in place the ideas of our Beloved Prophet.

Genetically Modified Organisms: Dr. Hortense Dodo's Campaign

"Genetically Modified Organisms are the agriculture of the 21st century and in this field, Africa must appropriate them". It is in these terms that Dr. Hortense Dodo of the Ivory Coast, teacher/researcher at the University of Alabama in the United States, urged students and specialists in biotechnology from the Ivory Coast to reveal the benefits of Genetically Modified Organisms. It was during an organized public conference on January 25th, at the University of Abidjan.

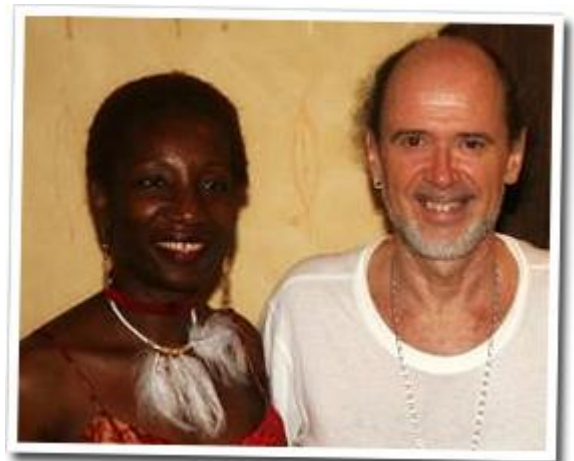
The main topic of the conference was "GMO, Risks and Prospects for Africa". The expert who denounced the campaigns carried out by anti-globalists against GMO, showed that no scientific study up to that point demonstrated the dangerous character of these products. On the contrary, their advantages are enormous, for the environment in particular, by considerably reducing insecticides and pesticides that pollute. The farmers themselves, according to Hortense Dodo, would benefit from it because we would see a reduction in the price of pesticides and insecticides, not to mention the substantial increase in agricultural output. Because of all these advantages, it is therefore useful for developing countries to use these GMOs.

Following her meeting with the President of the Republic, Hortense Dodo was invited to inaugurate the biotechnological city of the future in Bassam, in the beginning of March.

"Africa missed the Industrial Revolution, she does not have the right to miss the information revolution. In any case, Ivory Coast will not miss the Information Revolution. Whoever misses the Information Revolution is lost. Our role in history is to make sure that this revolution does not pass Africa by. Let us be African, for all Africans. Even if some do not see, let us see for them, as we did in the past with Cocoa. Let us see for them, for the Information Revolution, biotechnology. And it is what we are doing. Here, we will build the largest information city in Africa. Here, we will make sure that we grow rich, no longer only with the export of cocoa beans and coffee beans, but that which shapes the world of today. Have a good look at Japan, China, India, Asia..."

Hortense's speech

An Ivory Coast Scientist in the US

I am Doctor Hortense Dodo, director of the biotechnology food laboratory at the agricultural University of the State of Alabama. I am from the Ivory Coast, I studied mostly here, in Ivory Coast, before ending up in the United States where I have resided for about 20 years. I am therefore part of the diaspora from the Ivory Coast, and president of the Forum of the African Diaspora (FDA) in the United States. For this reason I would like to transmit to you the cordial greetings of your brothers and sisters of the diaspora. They are numerous, very qualified in several fields of expertise and they all nourish the dream to be put at the service of the development of the Ivory Coast and Africa.

Organizations such as the for Free Zone ZBTIC (Free [Trade] Zone for Biotech and Information Technology and Communications) offer real opportunity to attract these experts and investors whose abundant black diaspora resembles the Israeli diaspora which contributes considerably to the development of the State of Israël. As a scientist, I am an expert in food biotechnology.

What is biotechnology?

Biotech results from a marriage between the science of living organisms (biology) and a series of new fields such as molecular biology, data-processing, biochemistry, microbiology, etc. Biotechnology can be applied in several fields such as agriculture, medicine, pharmacy, energy and industry.

1. Agriculture

With agriculture, we're talking about transgenic agriculture or GMO (Genetically Modified Organisms), such as corn, soy, cotton or transgenic rice. In regards to the free zone, we intend to focus on food-production such as yam, manioc, banana and transgenic peanuts. For example, the market of peanuts in the eastern United States is 2,000 billion CFA Francs (more than the budget of Ivory Coast).

This figure would be even greater had it not been for the problem of peanut allergies which cause several hundred deaths each year among children. With my team including Dr. Konan, from the Ivory Coast, we have developed a new variety of transgenic peanut which does not cause allergies, by using the techniques of biotechnology. The production and the marketing of this peanut, which we have the patents to, could be accomplished in the free zone.

By just capturing 10% of the American market, that would be 200 billion CFA Francs.

The culture of transgenic food will contribute to the creation of employment, the development of national expertise and technological innovation.

2. Bio-Medicine

Bio-Medicine or the application of biotech to medicine such as stem cells, rejuvenation therapy and genetic therapy, makes it possible today to effectively cure disease such as diabetes, and to conduct organ transplants without rejection.

To develop such an expertise in the free zone would create an unquestionable centre of attraction. Tourists will flow there to benefit from high technology medical care and to benefit from the Ivory Coast's hospitality thus developing the concept of medical tourism.

In 2005, thanks to medical tourism, India acquired 175 billion CFA Francs.

By 2012, India plans to reach the amount of 1,250 billion CFA Francs in the medical tourism sector.

3. AIDS Cure

Hope of possible AIDS cures thanks to biotechnologies.

4. Energy

The application in the field of energy with the BioFuels in industry, etc.

Your Excellence, Mr. President of the Republic,

A dream can change a man, one man's dream can change a nation, the dream of a nation can change the course of humanity. The free zone is one of your dreams for Ivory Coast and Africa. This crossroads of advanced technologies will constitute a centre of attraction for the greatest minds of the world and will contribute enormously to the economic development of Ivory Coast. This zone could allow the African continent to be a part of globalization and to align on the same level... what am I saying? On a level of economic and scientific development higher than any other continent.

Yes, Ivory Coast and Africa can reach the future, but we must dare to dream big, we must even dare to dream of impossible dreams because the future belongs to the visionaries and to those who dare.

Celebration in Burkina Faso

This year, we celebrated the Festival of Femininity in Bobo-Dioulasso, which is the 2nd City in the Country which was selected to house the official national activities of the government in commemoration of March 8th. These activities took place between March 1st and 9th 61 aH. There was a conference on the subject of *"Education And Responsibility: Putting An End To Impunity For Violence Towards Women "*, as well as a popular cross-country race and a workshop forum.



The Raëlian Movement of Burkina Faso was obviously present at this celebration especially with the AVFE (l'Association Voie Féminine de l'Epanouissement - Association for the Path to Feminine Development), closely related to CLITORAID, which was created last November by Banémanie, our Bishop, which gathers Raëlian women in order to involve them more in actions within society and to make their voices heard. Therefore, we participated in preparation meetings which had begun a month earlier to in order to promote our association and CLITORAID.

On the 4th of March, we took part in the popular cross-country race and between March 6th - 7th, Banémanie and Abi joined in a workshop forum which was chaired by the Minister for the Promotion of Women.

429 women from the whole Country took part in this forum. Several exchanges took place, in particular, about the conditions of women in Burkina living in poverty, institutions providing micro credits which support women, violence towards women, education and responsibility of women, more involvement of women in national etc.

At the end of this forum, several recommendations were made, in particular: to reinforce the recruitment of girls into education, especially in the scientific field; to improve the image of women, especially in the media; to encourage women to denounce violence against them and younger girls; increased access for women to Micro Credit by reducing interest rates; to educate men to be respectful of women; to grant 30% of political positions and responsibility to women etc...

From March 7th to March 8th, we took part in a fair in the Bobo-Dioulasso Town Hall, where we had a stand which attracted many visitors and stimulated many interesting comments, thanks to our banner: "Yes To The Restoration Of The Clitoris". Many leaflets on CLITORAID were distributed to those who visited the stand. We had some very interesting exchanges with people who were astonished to learn of this good news about the possibility of reconstructing the clitoris. Petitions against excision were signed, and many women and girls registered for the operation of clitoral restoration.

On March 8th, at the Boulevard of the Revolution, the commemorative ceremony for Women's Day took place, chaired by the wife of the Head of State, in the presence of the authorities of the country, international institutions, embassies, NGOs and associations as well as tens of thousands of participants. A parade was scheduled in the program and that was what interested us the most that day. We were there at 7am, equipped with our March 8th loincloth, amongst



more than 100 associations of 25 people each, to take part in this parade. Contrary to other groups whose members appeared exhausted from standing in the sun for 3 hours, our group was in perfect harmony, enthusiastic and very animated, as well as the humour of 4 marvellous women who indulged us with many expressions on sex without taboo.

In fact, these women belong to an ethnic group which addresses the public on the theme of sexuality with superb ease, without taboo or shame. They are called the "Wolosso". They live in Burkina, Mali and the Ivory Coast.

They have the talent to express their messages on sexuality with humour and to get what they want from the person that they are talking to, while going as far as stripping without shame in the presence of other people, if they don't obtain what they want. When we told them about our activity they immediately joined us by distributing our leaflets with their talent while simply saying: "It's a document about vagina and penis!" and then people tore the leaflets from our hands like candy - hummmmmmm!!!!

An anecdote before continuing: when our Bishop Lamane, sponsor of our activity, walked by to support us, when he started kissing us, these marvellous women covered him with so many embraces that he had to flee - just to give you an idea about the environment we were in.

The parade finally began and our 3 meter long banner appeared, displaying in large letters: "YES TO THE RESTORATION OF THE CLITORIS, AVFE, www.clitoraid.org", held by 2 charming angels followed by others including our adorable Bishop Banemanie and our 4 brave women, lasting almost 500 meters before arriving at the official platform - that was a 'Boom'.

People applauded us throughout the parade when they saw our banner, and messages of support came from all around.

When we got close to the official platform, we stopped so that we could really show off the banner and there we received tons of applause as well. Our message was so special and extraordinary that the announcer commenting on the parade for the members of the official platform, the public and live television repeated the word "RESTORATION" three times, before being able to say, with their voice a little lower, the words "...OF THE CLITORIS" as if he were afraid or ashamed. Hehehe!!!

YIPPEE! We achieved our goal as tens of thousands of people who were present saw us, as well as millions of people who watched tv, because they saw us direct on national television as well as by satellite.

While we marched, our Raëlian brothers were immensely pleased to enjoy the positive reactions of the participants when they noticed our banner as they distributed the leaflets. Like Bobo-Dioulasso, our Raëlian brothers and sisters in other places around the country took part in activities commemorating of this day by distributing leaflets.

At FESPACO as well!!

The 20th edition of the FESPACO (Panafrican Film and Television Festival of Ouagadougou) was held between February 24th and March 4th, 2007 with the theme being: "cinema and cultural diversity";

It was a wonderful occasion for the Raelian Movement which, for a long time, has been preaching cultural diversity, especially the protection and respect of all cultures in general and African in particular. The main topics which were carried there by the banner and the exchanges with the public were:

- "Adam and Eve were black; Africans – don't have any hang ups; find your roots and your culture while keeping your head in the Sciences of the Future ";
- "Raël launching the 'Adopt a Clitoris' program"

We undertook several activities including:

- A display stand set up on the main site of FESPACO;



- Collecting signatures for a petition against excision;
- The distribution of various leaflets of which the first reiterates the essence of the contents of the press release "RAËL launches the United Kingdoms of Kama! Several traditional chiefs support the initiative " and the second entitled "'Africa Paradis! More than a film.... soon a reality! As RAËL had predicted!" showing the similarity of ideas between the contents of the film "Africa Paradis" by the Beninese director Sylvestre AMOUSSOU and of Our Beloved Prophet's prophecies;
- Various contacts with directors including Sylvestre AMOUSSOU, who directed the film "Africa Paradis", to whom we forwarded the letter of the Continental Guide, accompanied by 3 samples of the **collection of the words of the Prophet** and the leaflet showing support for his film; each of the other directors received a copy as well as the leaflet of support for "Africa Paradis";
- An invitation for all raelians go to see the film "Africa Paradis"; this is how the National Guide benefitted from the national television of Burkina to congratulate and encourage the producer at the end of a showing of this film; he also pointed out that Africa is the future of humanity and that we are all brothers and must make things improve together.

The reactions of the public to the activities of the Movement are varied, with a constant enthusiasm, taking our booth by storm at FESPACO. We recorded approximately 4,000 visitors at our stand including: 3,343 simple readers, 657 non-Raelian people who took part in 384 talks. 12 books and 25 samples of the Collected Words of the Prophet were sold, 7,000 leaflets were distributed. We donated the collection of the words of the Prophet to 10 film directors, 17 journalists and other media representatives. 637 signatures for the petition from which 242 men and 395 women among whom, 67 registered to benefit from the restoration of the clitoris, the 328 other remaining women wished to ask for their husbands opinion before making a decision; some women asked their partner right there for their opinion before registering for the restoration of their clitorises.

In one of the rooms where Raelians watched the film "Africa Paradis", the room was so full that many film enthusiasts had to sit in the corridors inside the movie theater. Our actions of diffusion and support with the leaflets certainly was not unusual considering the public's interest in this film.

In conclusion, this 20th FESPACO was a beautiful media harvest for us as well as an advancement in the fulfillment of Our Beloved Prophet RAËL's prophecies, who we thank infinitely for having agreed to show us the way of happiness and blossoming.

Woman's Day In Benin, with Clitoraid as the Theme

In Cotonou, a team of 5, led by Fikira, held up a banner in the market of Dantokpa, around fifty signatures were collected and leaflets were distributed. During this time, thanks to the support of a school principal who was introduced to me by Light, I was given the authorization of an inspector to hold discussion conferences in schools: 2 conferences in the course of the day, conferences targeting the CE2, CM1 and CM2.

The first conference saw 500 pupils from 4 schools, the second - 400 pupils from 5 schools.

Supported by drawings on the blackboard, I taught them showing how one removed such and such genitals finally arriving at the infibulation. The children shouted extremely loud that they would never let that happen and the little boys promised that they would defend their small sisters until the end so that it would never happen to them. The directors asked them to let them know if somebody was in danger. It was specified that the law prohibited these practices. The directors have my co-ordinates, if any of the moms would like a lecture. They offered to put their establishment at my disposal, in that case.

The site for clitoraid was also given out.

Ivory Coast - Zero Tolerance for Sexual Mutilations Day

The interviewer, 'ASH-K', asked us how to get involved with clitoraid and she promised she would help us meet the World Health Organization and get us on television so that women can see us and know that it's true, because the show wasn't taking calls, but there were many. We were on for 2 and a half hours instead of 2.

At the second one -Radio Yopougon, where we went to at 3pm - the interviewer made us go on at 16h15 and the 2 hour show was reduced to 45mn. She did nothing but interview people who practiced and were for excision and did not accept that anyone speak about Clitoraid, nor the fact that I underwent an operation to find my clitoris, that women should have hope and that it is finally possible. She went as far as to ask whether it was not normal that men controlled women's sexuality. Incredible!!!
